

## Morocco COVID Restrictions

Last updated: 10/04/2021

### Entry restrictions:

- Requirement to be fully vaccinated two weeks before arrival (FTS policy)
- Additional negative PCR test no older than 48 hours in French, English or Arabic required for list B countries → **THIS INCLUDES TRANSIT**

### Current restrictions

- Curfew between 11pm and 5am for everyone
- No gatherings with more than 50 people, but possible to obtain permit from local authorities
- Cafés and restaurants are open until 11pm, masks to be worn when entering, temperature is checked (in reality mostly not the case), limited to 50% of capacity
- Gyms and hammams open with 50% capacity
- Hotels and accommodation facilities are open, but limited to 75% of capacity
- Unlimited travel upon presentation of vaccine pass or administrative authorization
- Masks are mandatory in the entire country
- Public transport allows 75% of capacity
- Seems like they will be reaching their goal of vaccinating 80% of the population by December
